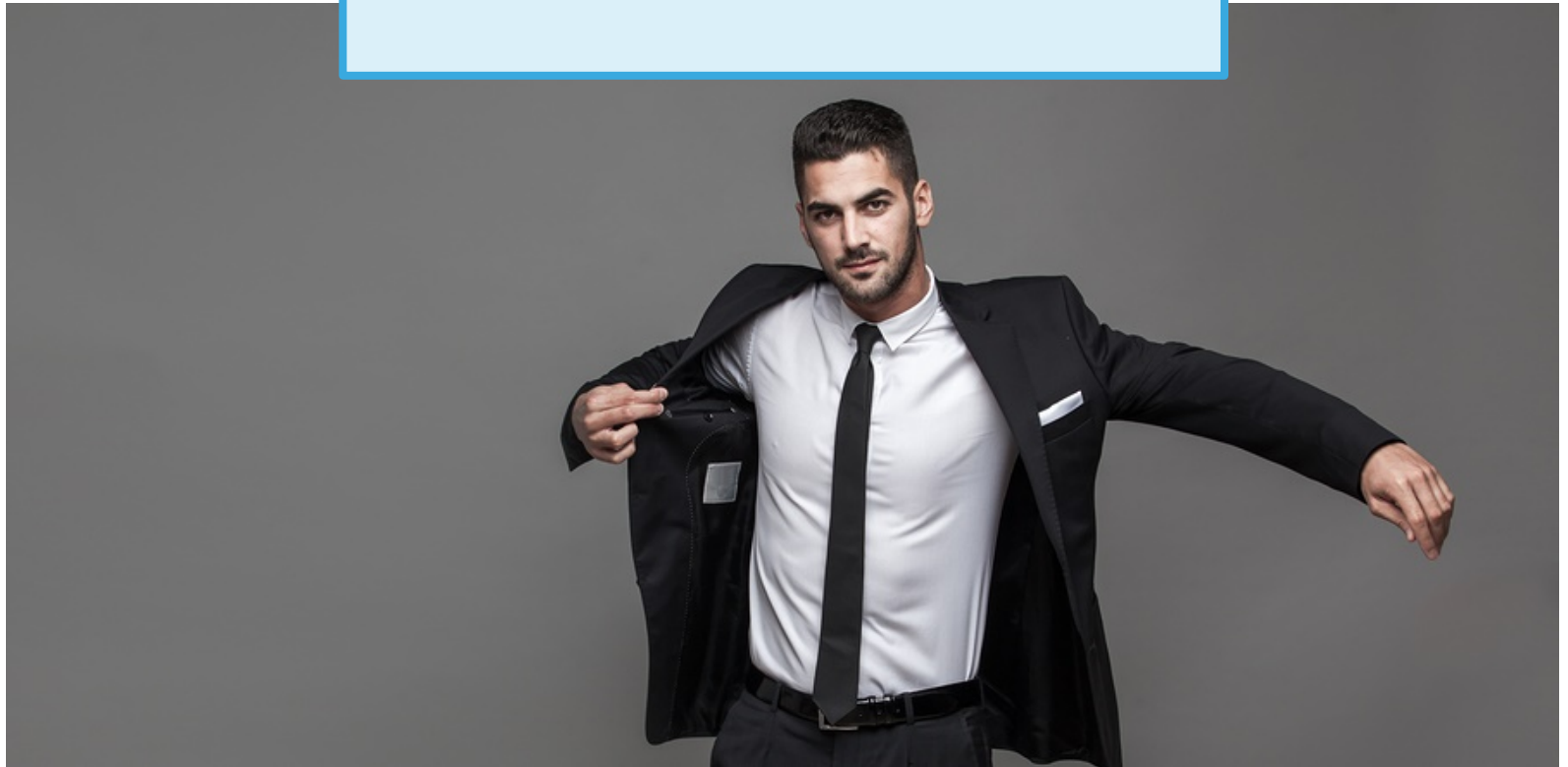


bride
