I hike and run when it is summer and it is hot and sunny.






I swim in the pool in the winter and in the ocean in the summer.


I don't swim only in the summer or the winter. I swim every month of the year!





We can use **like** with nouns.

positive	negative
l like summer.	l don't like winter.
He likes June.	He doesn't like December.



■ We can also use **like** and **don't like** with verbs.

- We can use **like** with **to** verbs.
- We can use **like** with **-ing** verbs.

positive or negative	-to verb	-ing verb
like	to swim.	swimm ing .
l don't like	to hike.	hik ing .
He likes	to ski.	ski ing .
He doesn't like	to run.	runn ing .


Basketball uses a basket with a net.

We usually play football outside.






Sometimes we play basketball inside and sometimes we play basketball outside.

We use **play** with **sports** that do not have their own verb.

l play tennis.	l run.
l like playing tennis.	I like running .
He plays basketball.	He swims .
He likes playing basketball.	He likes swimming .




I like basketball

- We can use **like** with nouns.
- We can use **like** with verbs.
 - We can use **like** with **to** verbs.
 - We can use **like** with **-ing** verbs.

with nouns	with <i>to</i> verbs	with –ing verbs
l like football.	l like to play football.	l like play ing football.
She likes volleyball.	She likes to play volleyball.	She likes play ing volleyball.
We don't like basketball.	We don't like to play basketball.	We don't like play ing basketball.
He doesn't like tennis.	He doesn't like to play tennis.	He doesn't like play ing tennis.






Many **sports** use balls.
