




She **shops** for a pink shirt because she wants a new one.

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She **buys** a pink top when she finds one she likes.

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
She **pays** for the pink top and now it is her shirt.

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
The pink top **costs** 50 euros!

Steve then finds a coat that costs just 50 euros, which is perfect. That's exactly how much money he brought with him to the mall.







I pay for the pink top at the **till**.

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
How much **money** do you have in your purse?

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I don't have that much **cash** in my pocket.

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
I need to pay with my **card** instead.

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I can use my card to get cash from the **ATM**.

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




Do you want to pay by cash or card?

If you don't have that much cash, you can pay with card.






Where is the ATM? I can get more cash.











The price is twenty euros.


OK, I'll pay by cash.
